

Minor vs. Major Infractions

Major Infractions	Definitions
Profanity/Inappropriate Language	Verbal message that includes swearing and/or words used in an inappropriate manner
Fighting	Serious Physical Contact (ex. Hitting or Kicking)
Verbal Threat	Detailed words delivered to harm another student with the intent to follow through with the threat
Refusal to Leave Classroom	Student refuses to leave the classroom
Refusal to Give Electronic Device to Teacher	Student refuses to give electronic device to teacher after being asked
Failure to Report to Office	Student fails to report to front office or student services when requested
Habitual Dress Code Violation	Following a student's 2nd dress code violation
Leaving Class w/out Permission	Student leaves the classroom without teacher's permission
Skiping Class	Student fails to attend class
Defiance/Disrespect: Teacher Directed (Excessive)	Excessive failure to respond to teacher's request and/or shows major disrespect (ex. Yelling at teacher)
Willful Disobedience (Excessive)	Continual instances of noncompliance
Disruptions (Excessive)	Continual behavior causing classroom disruption (ex. Sustained yelling, talking, out of seat, making noise with materials)
Throwing Objects (Directed)	Maliciously throwing an object
Alcohol/Tobacco/Drug Possession	Student in possession of alcohol, tobacco, and/or drugs
Forgery	Student falsifies document
Stealing	Take without permission
Possession of Weapon or Look Alike Weapon	Student possesses a weapon or look alike weapon
Bullying	Student verbally or physically intimidates another student
