

Minor vs. Major Infractions

Minor Infractions	Definitions
Tardy	Being late to school or class
Dress Code Violation	Wearing clothes that do not comply with dress code guidelines
Off Task Behaviors	Actions not pertaining to the lesson
Unauthorized Use of Computer/Web Page	The viewing of an unauthorized web page or not using the computer in the matter it is intended to be used
Inappropriate Hallway Behavior	Running, excessive noise, eating, wearing of hoods, and loitering
Disruptions (Minimal)	Minor talking or actions that cause classroom disruption (ex. Laughing, brief talking, making noise with materials)
Willful Disobedience (Minimal)	Brief failure of noncompliance
Defiance/Disrespect: Teacher Directed (Minimal)	Brief failure to respond to teacher's request and/or shows minor disrespect (ex. Rolling of eyes, sigh, etc.)
Annoyance/Rudeness to Others	Use of words or actions that annoys others and causes a disruption Use of words that are not polite. (ex. Shut Up)
Teasing/Taunting (Minimal)	Unwarranted words or actions that focuses on a negative and/or provokes verbal or physical response
Throwing Objects in Class (Non-Directed)	Throwing objects not directed at anyone in a malicious manner (ex. Paper at trash can, tossing pens, etc.)
Sleeping	Student sleeping in class
Horseplay	Not serious bt inappropriate physical contact
Verbal Threat (Non-Specific)	Student delivers a message with no specific details or intent to follow through
Lack of Preparedness	Not having the materials required to be successful
Cheating	Student uses another students work
Gum/Food in Class without Permission	Chewing gum or eating food in class (Water is the only thing allowed!)
Leaving Seat w/out Permission	Student leaving seat without the permission of the teacher
Failure to Follow Directions (Minimal)	Brief, noncompliance of directions
Possession of Electronic Device	Student possession of electronic device without the intent of using or actually using the device
