Dear Parents/Guardians:

In an effort to create a better flow of school traffic and in the interest of safety for our students, we are implementing new practices for morning and afternoon drop-off for car riders who attend Little Oak Middle School. Beginning Monday, October 31st, the one-way directional flow will be enforced from Stone Street to Rebel Drive and then to Coral Street between the hours of 6:00 AM to 6:00 PM. Buses will also follow this one-way route so be mindful that they will need to go around vehicles as they make their way to campus to pick-up the students.

As per policy already in place, the teachers' "limestone" parking lot on Little Oak's property cannot be used to bypass the car line. All car riders should follow the flow of traffic which goes through Boyett's rear parking lot. The only exception will be those students with special needs whose parents are permitted to park in handicapped parking to escort their students into the building.

Beginning October 31st the afternoon carline will go through Boyett Jr. High's rear parking lot as it currently flows in the mornings. Only buses will be permitted to come in the Little Oak drive. Remember, as per our Parent/Student Handbook, students cannot be checked out from school after 2:00 PM unless it is an emergency. As to block in the buses that are parked, parents will need to wait until at least 2:15 PM before lining up in the Boyett parking lot. Once all our buses have picked up the students, the car line will move through Boyett's parking lot to Little Oak and on to Coral Street.

We realize that change is sometimes confusing or difficult, but we feel that by utilizing the additional span of roadway available by going through the parking lot will relieve some of the congestion our parents have to endure on Pearl Street and the side streets leading to our schools.

For your convenience a map is being included with this letter. If you have any questions or concerns please contact your appropriate administrator. Thank you in advance for your cooperation as we work hard to make your carline experience a little more pleasant and our students safer.
